

## *37' Sea Ray Sundancer - 2007*

This 2007 37' Sea Ray Sundancer offers a sleek racy profile. She has plenty of space for a group of six or less passengers to get out on the water and soak in the South Florida sunshine. She offers spacious seating in the cockpit along with a sink and table.





Below deck, the galley hosts an unbelievable amount of counter space along with a two-burner stove, microwave, and refrigerator. The dinette has ample room for four people to sit for dinner or drinks. There is also a fully enclosed fiberglass head with a vacu-flush head, shower, sink and vanity. The owner's stateroom is spacious with a raised pedestal berth. In the main salon, the galley is to port and a curved seating area and dining table is to starboard; all surrounded by finely finished cherry-finished cabinetry. Aft there is another seating area. The environment is always comfortable as the yacht is equipped with air conditioning. Accommodations are absolutely gorgeous.



The large cockpit area has everything for relaxing and entertaining which includes a refreshment center wet bar with beverage holders as well as an ice cooler to cool your beverages of choice. The aft deck provides wrap-around seating with a removable cockpit table, and a convenient wet bar. The deck offers a Sunbrella® Bimini top to offer shade from the Florida sun. Off the transom is an integrated swim platform that allows direct access to the water. The deck forward of the helm station is very large and inviting as a place to feel the breeze or enjoy sunbathing on the sun-pads. The entertainment area of this yacht is amazing – with open space everywhere.
